BIOL 2022 (Ecology and Conservation): Substitute for Bio 375 Mar 21 2013

BIOL 2023 (Functional anatomy):

Approved as a four credit lecture/lab upper-level elective for the Biology major in the Group B: Organisms category. Does not substitute for BIO 325 Vertebrate Morphology or BIO 350 Gen/Comp Vertebrate Physiology, so those courses can also be taken by the student. Also does not substitute for BIO 226 or 227 so those courses can also be taken by the student. The course will fulfill a “cell and molecular course” requirement of the BNS major.

BIOL 2036 (Physiology & Neuroscience 2 (half))

Approved as a three credit **lecture** upper-level elective for the Biology major in the Group B: organism category (the “lab” for BIOL 2036 only meets one time during the semester). This course is equivalent to BIO 350, therefore students who take this course should NOT take BIO 350 at Centre.
